The Forum was unanimously decided to be named as "Arabic Literary Forum". The main objectives of the forum were framed as mentioned below:

- 1. To develop expertise in oratory, write-ups, lectures, dramas and couplet chanting (*baitbazi*), etc. in Arabic
- 2. To introduce the contemporary styles of academic debate and discussion
- 3. To develop presentation skills
- 4. To impart training along the lines of managing seminars, conferences and workshops, etc.
- 5. To inculcate the spirit of mutual cooperation and affiliation with the teamwork
- 6. To make acquainted with the current Arabic journalistic trends and encourage to participate in the publication of Arabic journals and magazines

In order to achieve the above mentioned objectives and make the efforts bear fruits the forum divided its activities under the following four sections:

- a. Literary Wing
- b. Cultural Wing
- c. Publication Wing
- d. Professor Abdul Moiz Memorial library

The Forum primarily focuses on academic issues and social problems faced by the mankind and on developing the technique of attaining proficiency and fluency of speaking Arabic through listening, speaking, reading and writing. Furthermore it encourages the students to take more practical measures about academic planning, scheduling of time slots as well as enhancing mental orientation.
